SECURE YOUR PARK'S FUTURE

Imagine a world where no bird song could be heard in the park or where our children or grandchildren had no adequate outdoor space to play.

By leaving Your Park a gift in your Will, you can help ensure that our much-loved parks remain the vibrant, nature rich spaces needed for future generations to enjoy together and make memories within.

Leaving a legacy to Your Park will also help ensure disadvantaged people have equal access to green spaces. This is even more pertinent with 1 in every 8 UK households having no garden.

We are one of only a few parks foundations but together, and with your help, our work can have a lasting effect on our communities and society.





YOUR GIFT TO FUTURE GENERATIONS

For every £1 donated to Your Park, 73 pence is spent on our charitable mission, including community gardening sessions for refugees, nature walks with school children and introducing natural habitats to city-centres.

After taking care of family and friends, leaving a gift in your Will to Your Park is an incredible way to support the local community. There are three main types of legacy:

Residuary: Part, or all, of your estate's value (after taxes and expenses are paid), guaranteeing fair distribution.

Pecuniary: A fixed sum of money. If you would like to protect the value of your gift from diminishing over the years, you could index linking the gift.

Specific: A gift of personal property including shares and artwork.

If you haven't made a Will, it can be arranged under a solicitor's guidance.

If you already have a Will, amendments can be made at any time.

To include Your Park in your Will you will need to provide the following information, which you can show your solicitor:

Charity name: Bristol and Bath Parks Foundation (working name 'Your Park')

Registered charity number: 1182217

Registered address: PO Box 1702, Bristol, BS49 4YW

We always encourage gifts without restricting their usage, because we don't know where our focus will be most needed when we receive your gift. Unrestricted gifts allow us to reach parks and communities which most need support.
